

Suggestions for ways to meet requirement 5b

Provide education about cancer clinical trials.

- ❑ Post the National Cancer Institute (NCI) brochure *Taking Part in Cancer Treatment Research Studies* on intranet or make hard copies available to employees.
- ❑ Educate employees about how to access information about specific cancer clinical trials by providing links to web-based resources that provide information on specific trials (e.g. American Cancer Society (ACS), National Cancer Institute (NCI), clinicaltrials.gov, etc.).
- ❑ Provide patients with assistance in navigating the cancer clinical trial system e.g., patient advocacy services, disease management resources, other navigator services.
- ❑ Designated an individual(s) to act as a resource person for employees or family members diagnosed with cancer.
- ❑ Encourage employees to discuss available treatment options, including clinical trials, with their healthcare provider.
- ❑ Offer Lunch 'n Learn workshops on quality cancer care including clinical trials, and invite outside speakers, appropriate to the particular topic.
- ❑ Highlight employee cancer survivor stories on company website, including acknowledging participation in a clinical trial.
